

Cookie policy

Introduction

On this page, you will find more information about what cookies are and the cookie policy that Boost-your-language follows.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small files with information that our server sends to your browser with the intention that this information will be sent back to our server on your next visit. The use of cookies is not harmful to your computer.

2. Which Cookies Does Boost-your-language use?

2.1. Functional Cookies

We always place functional cookies, and they are necessary for the website to function correctly. These cookies have little impact on your privacy and are used anonymously.

2.2. Analytical Cookies

With analytical cookies, we can measure website visits, such as how often our site is visited and what information visitors are looking for. This way, we know which parts of the site are popular and how we can improve our website. The statistics we collect cannot be traced back to individuals. This data is anonymized after collection. We track the following information:

- The number of visitors to our web pages.
- How long a visitor stays on our site.
- What visitors search for (search queries).
- Information about your browser and device with which you visit our website, such as operating system and screen size.
- How you arrived at our website (e.g., by clicking on one of our ads or a link in an email).
- The speed of our website to measure your browser. This information allows us to timely identify and solve potential performance issues of our website.

Both types of cookies are used by default and do not require user consent.

3. Personal Data

We can only collect personal data if it has been provided by you through the contact forms. Only the information provided by you is known to us and is included in our CRM environment to better serve you. We do not collect unsolicited (personal) data that is not necessary to fulfill a contact or information request. When your data is known to us, additional data may be collected, such as website and page visits. Your data may also be used to contact you by phone or email and/or be included in our marketing actions.

4. Google Analytics

Boost-your-language automatically collects information about your browsing behavior during the use of the website through Google Analytics, including but not limited to how often certain pages are viewed. This information includes your IP address and the type of browser you use. We can never trace an IP address back to a specific user. We place these cookies to gain insight into visitor behavior and to improve Boost-your-language based on this information.

The information collected via the Google Analytics cookie is transmitted to and stored by Google Analytics on servers in the United States. Google Analytics claims to adhere to the Safe Harbor Principles and is affiliated with the Safe Harbor program of the U.S. Department of Commerce. This means that there is an adequate level of protection for the processing of personal data.

5. Managing Cookies

You can set your browser to not store cookies, and you can also delete all previously stored information via your browser settings. For more information on managing cookies, refer to your browser's help documentation.

We may update this cookie policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices or for other operational, legal, or regulatory reasons. We encourage you to review this policy periodically to stay informed about how we use cookies.
